OTHER EVIDENCE OF RECOGNITION?

DMT professionals are paid as part of multidisciplinary rehabilitation team in psychiatry and physical and social rehabilitation.

DMT professionals are trained by state accredited University study program.

Every year the study program also receives state-funded study positions and university scholarships

DMT - PSYCHOTHERPY OR NOT IN LATVIA?

Dance movement therapists are healthcare professionals, but psychotherapists - medical doctors. Both specializations have a different regulation. According to the Medical Treatment Law, Dance and movement therapists in Latvia are recognized as functional specialists, together with physiotherapists, occupational therapists etc.

We consider that the full state recognition process in our country succeeded because all four specializations of art therapies were represented as one professional body.
