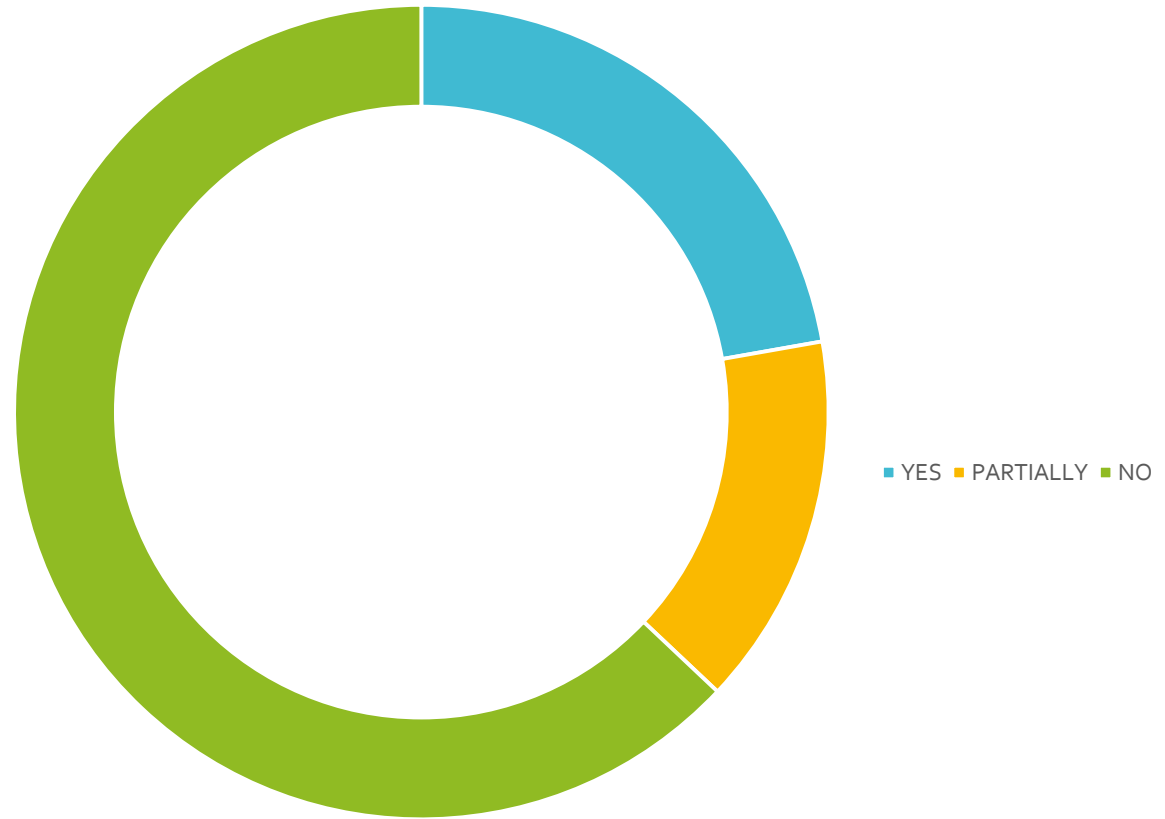

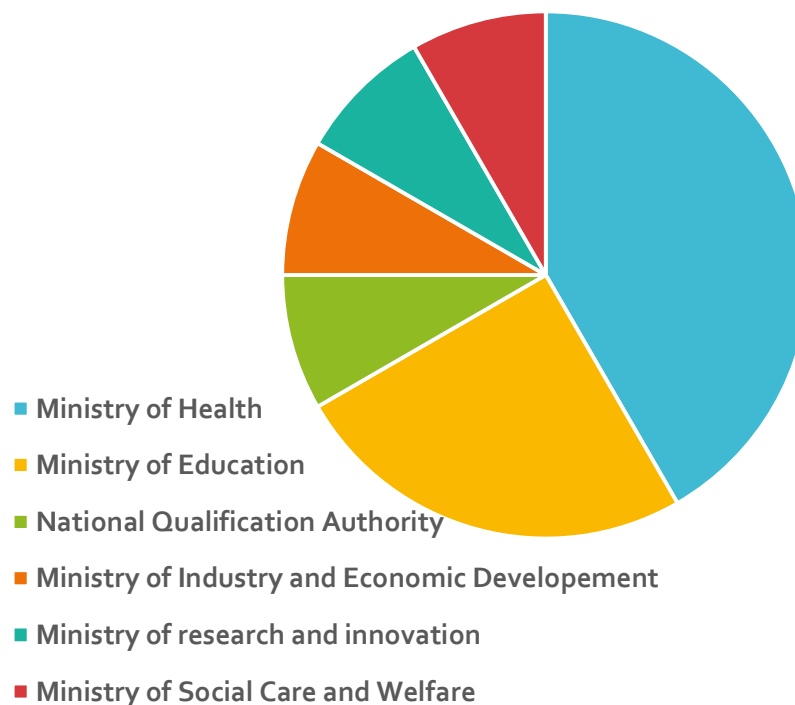
1. Is DMT recognized by your Government/State?
(27 answers)



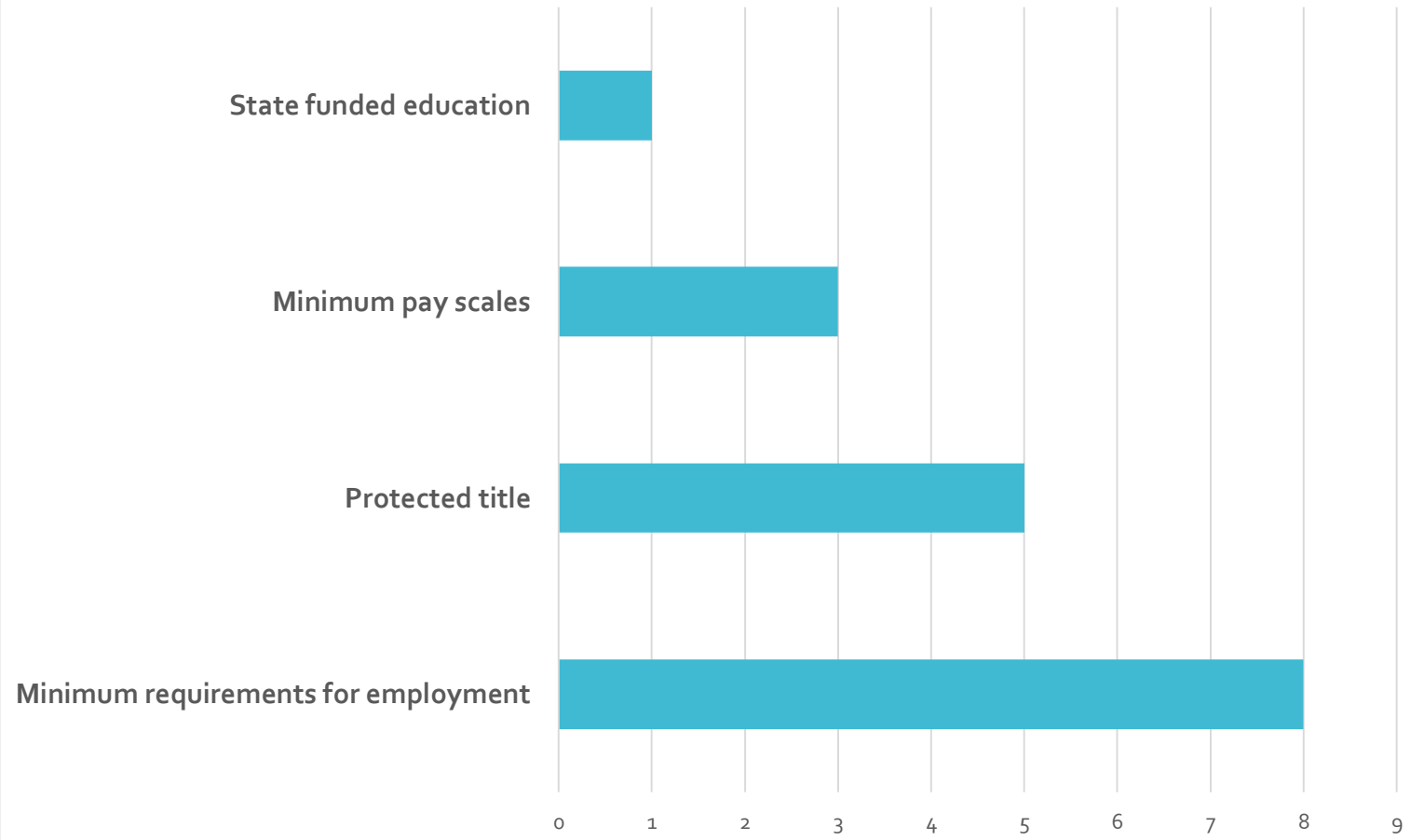

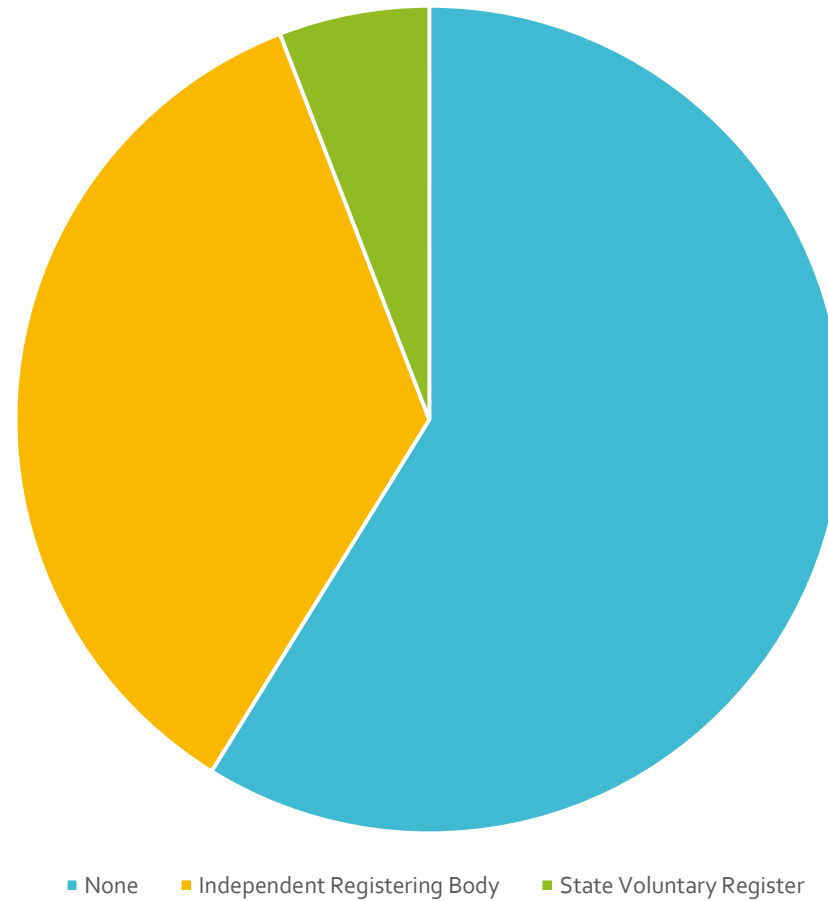

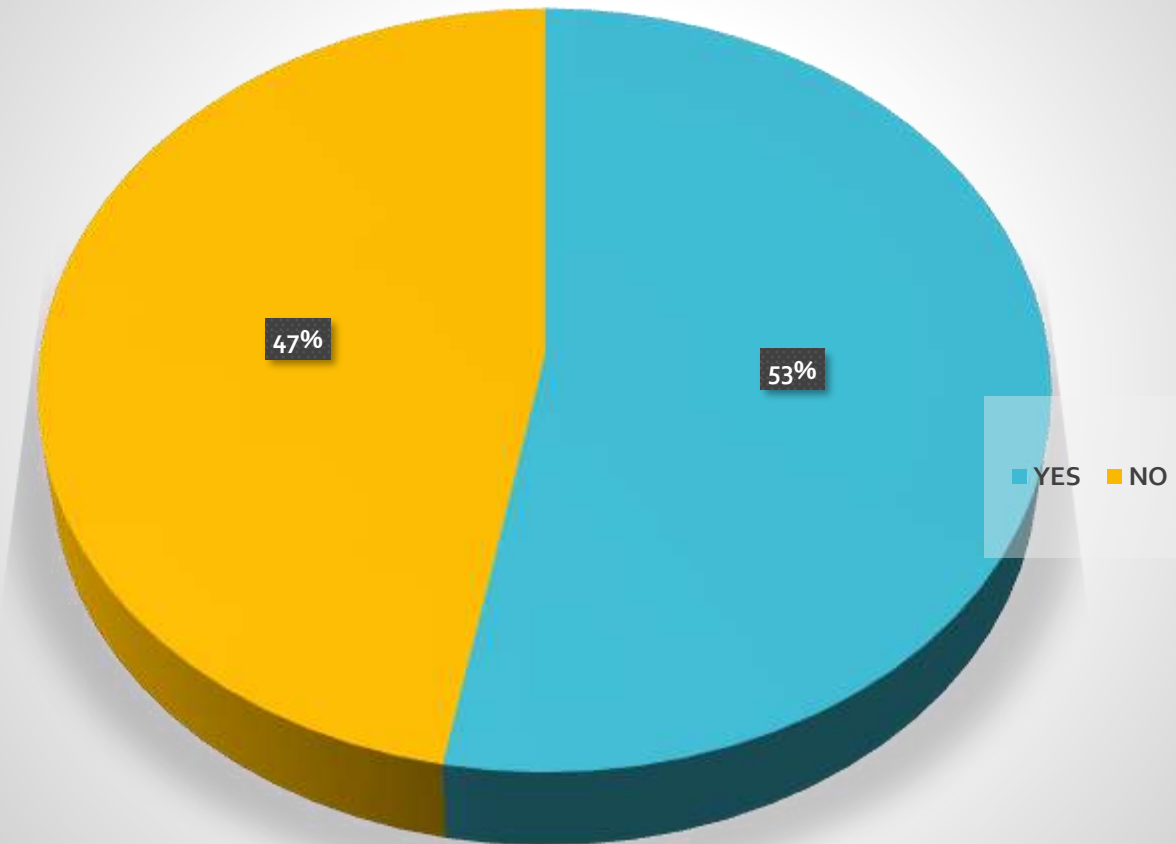

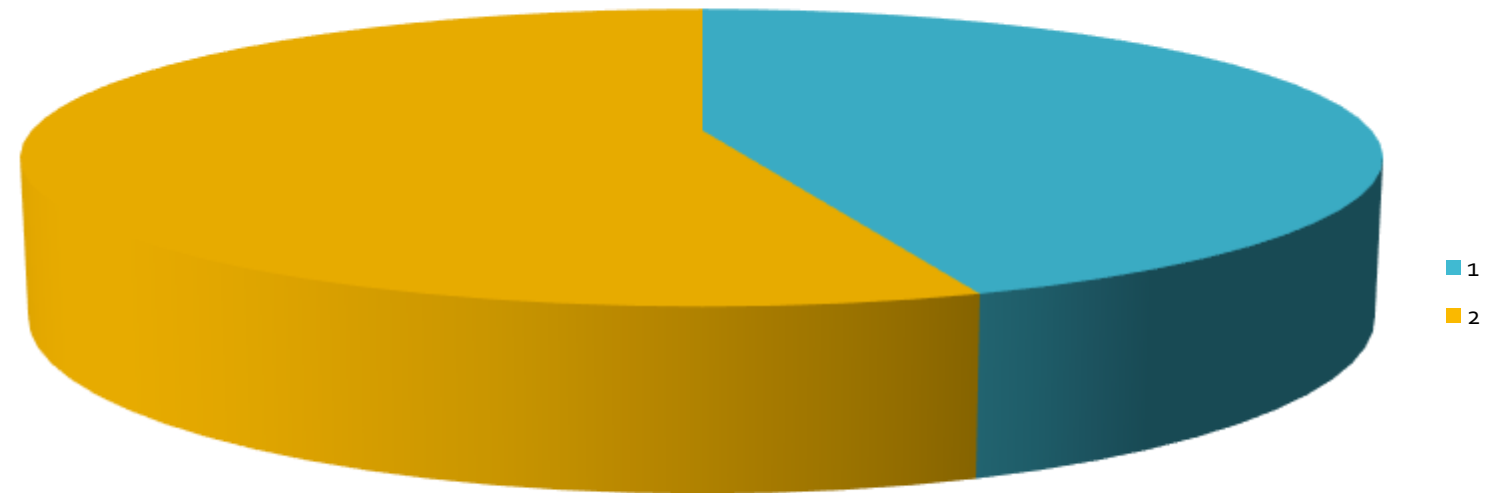

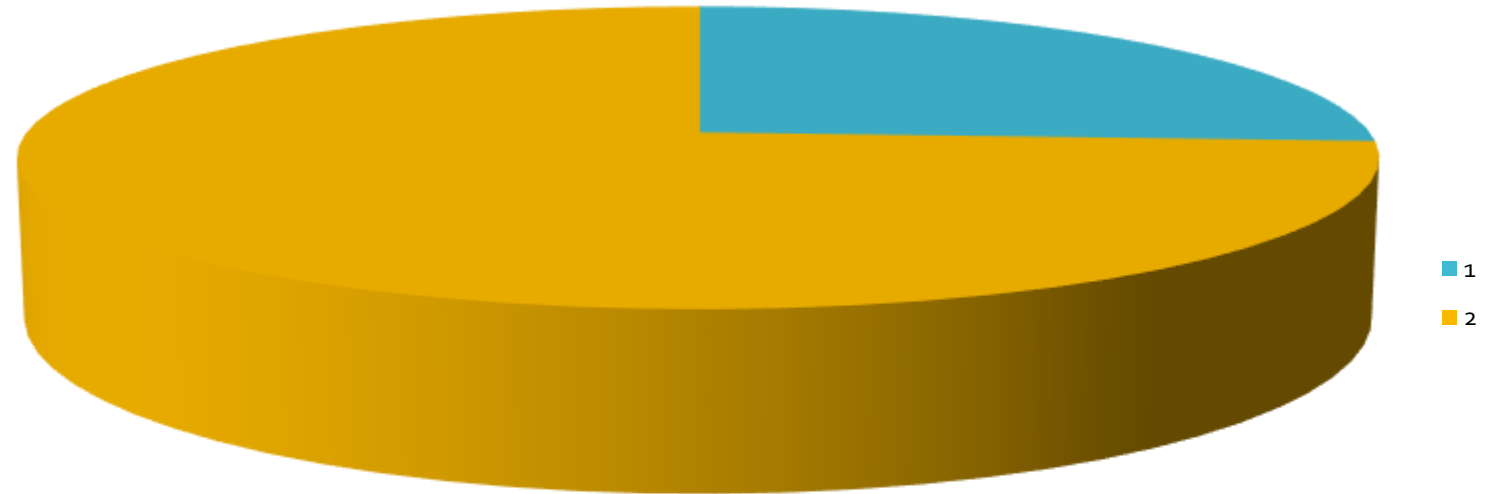

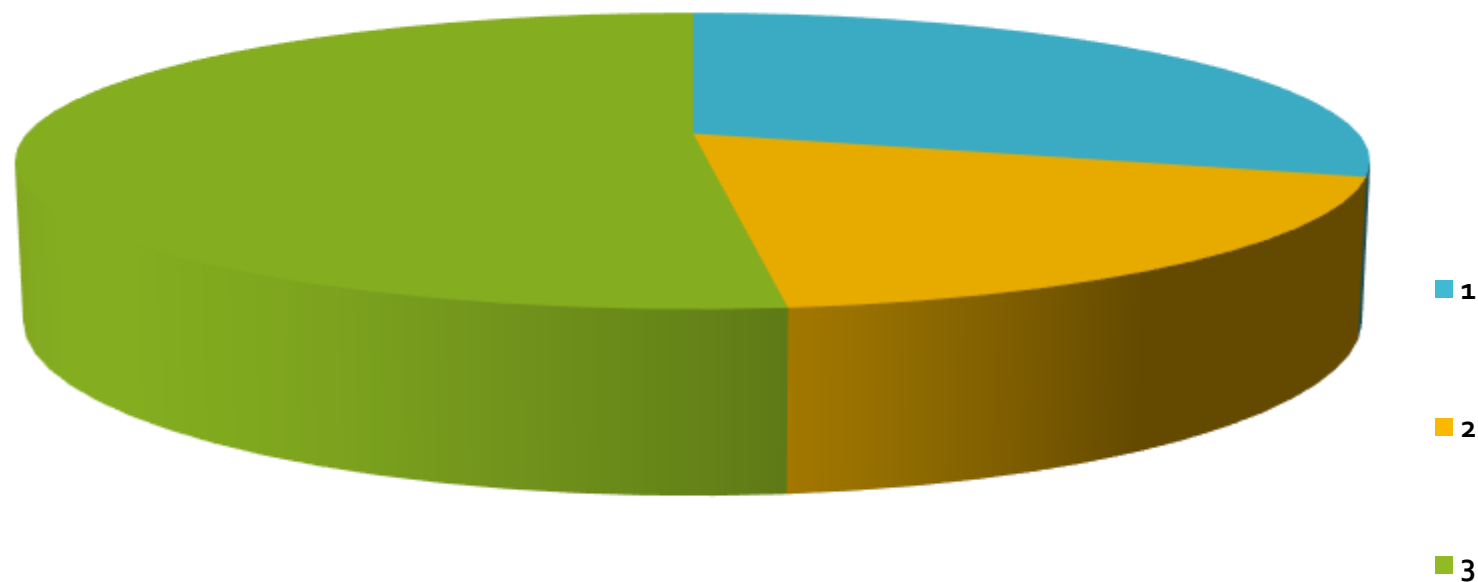

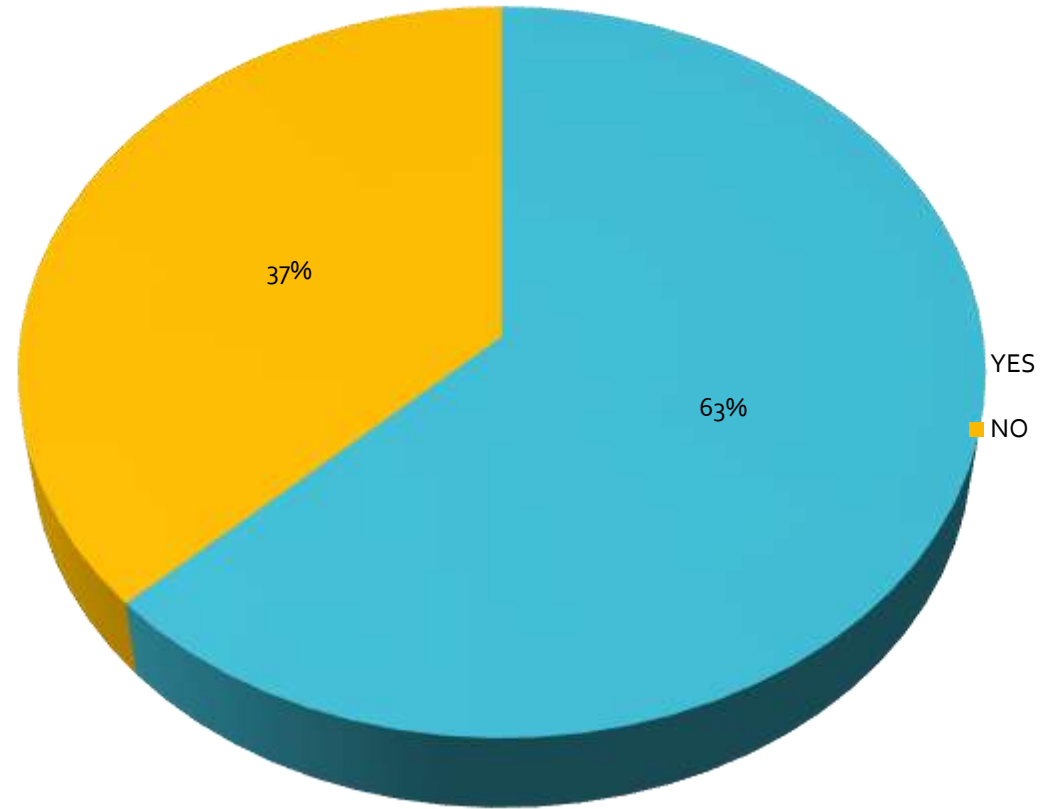

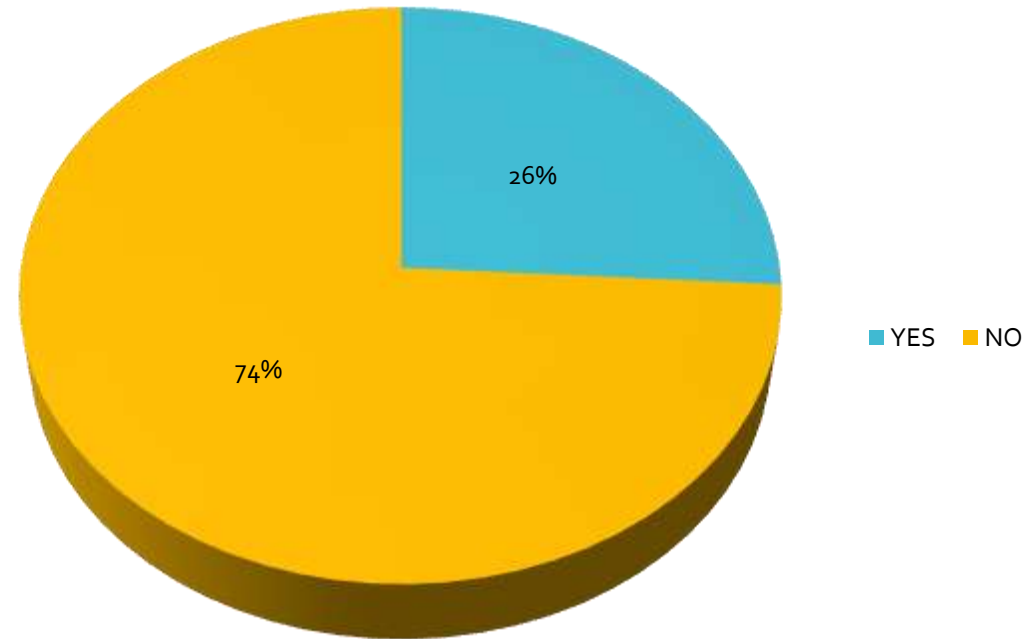

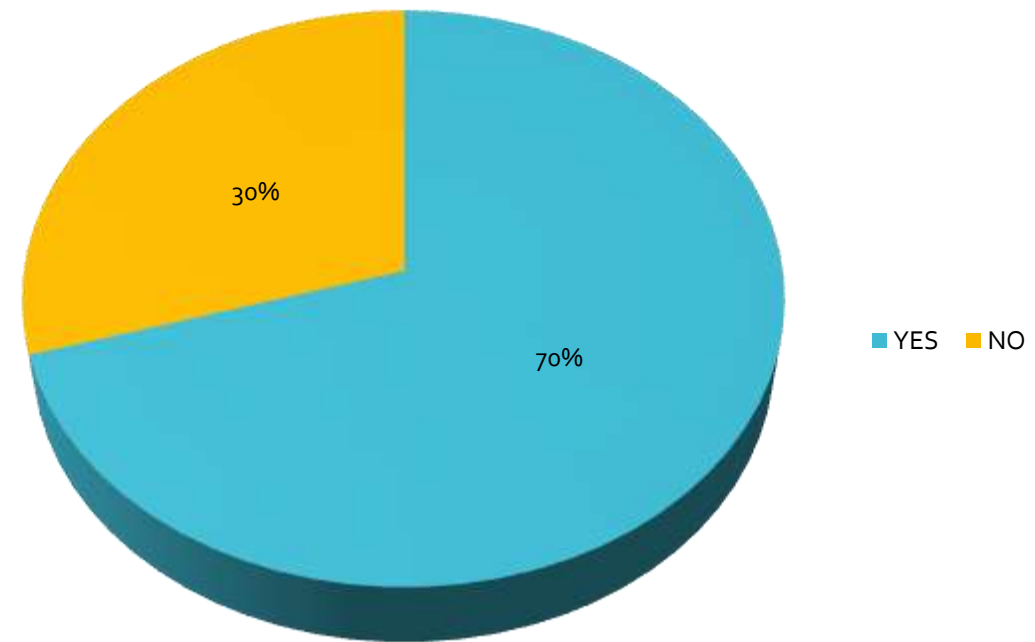

Whats is the staus of DMT compared to other art therapies?



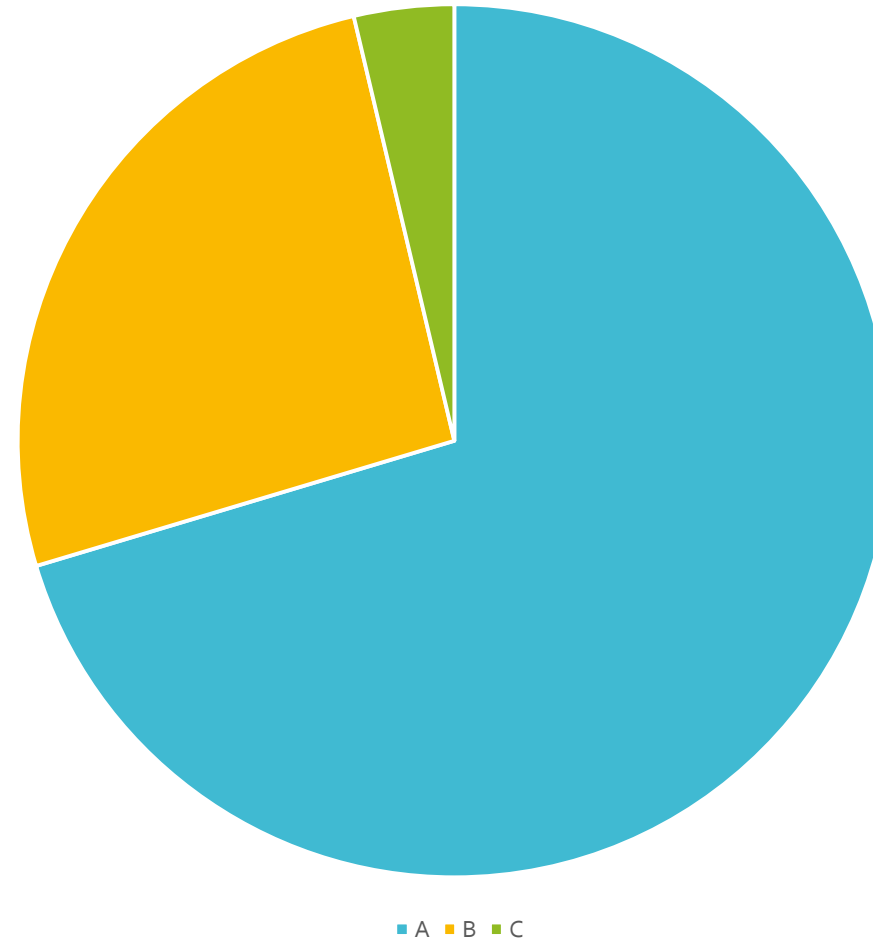

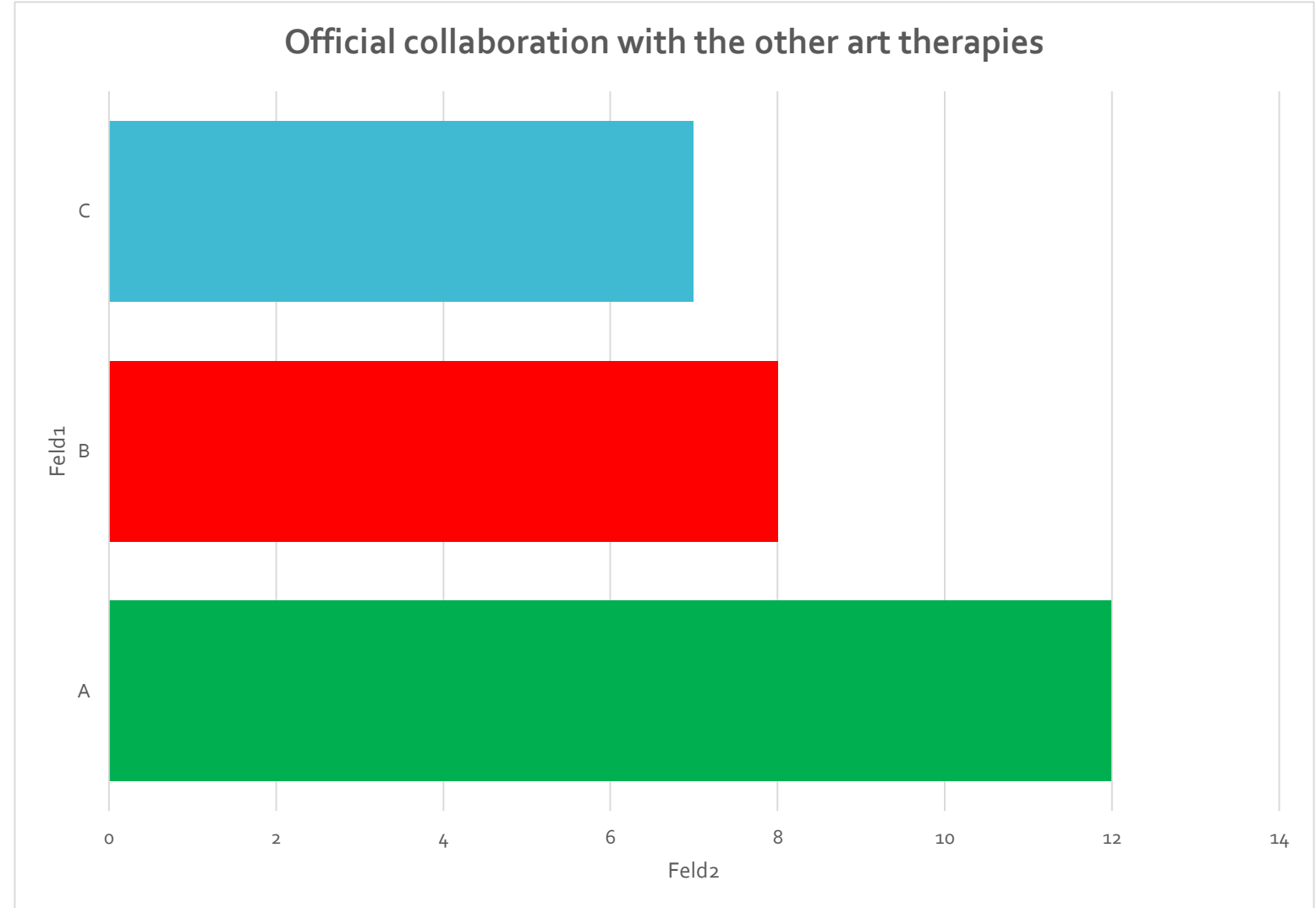

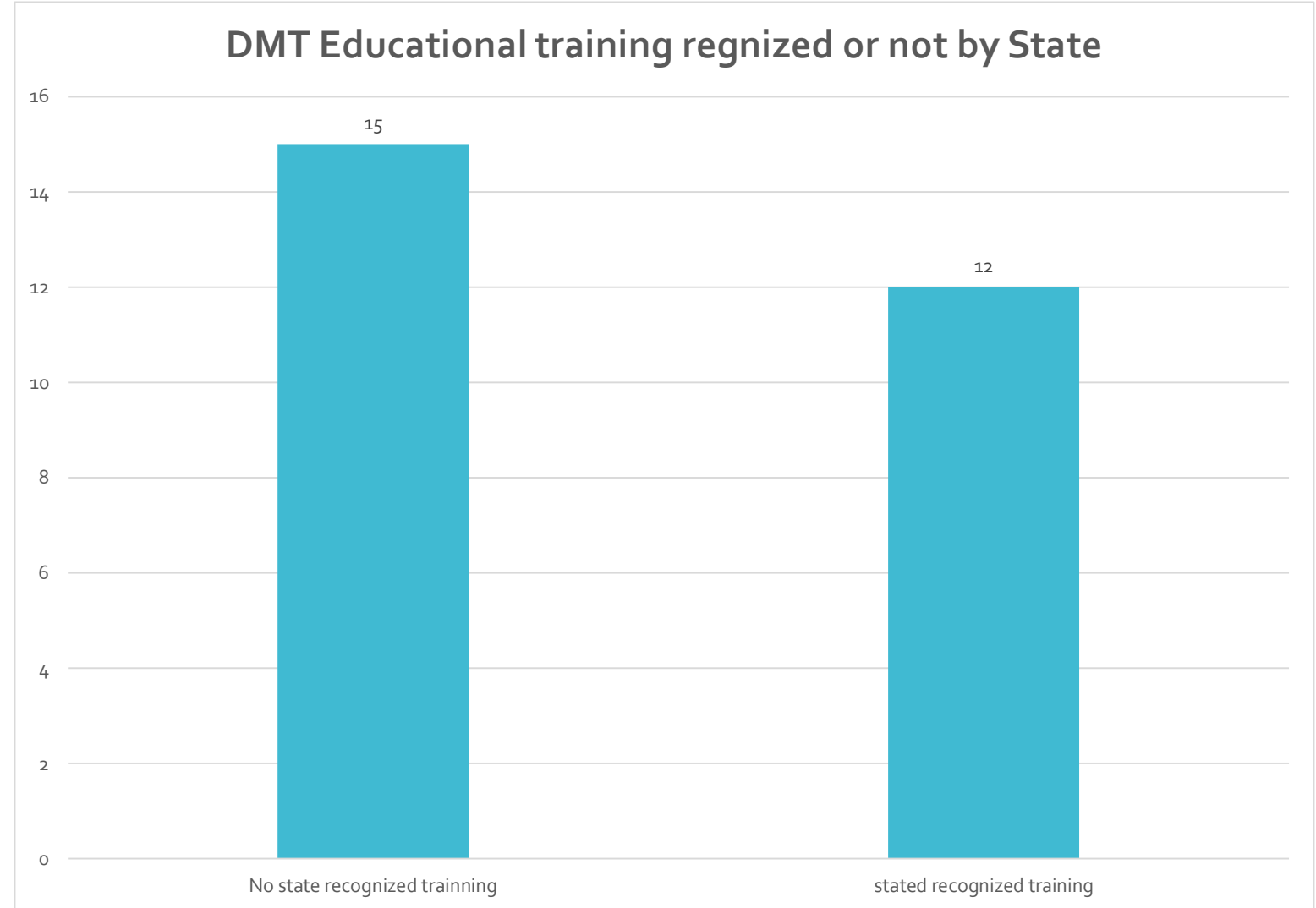

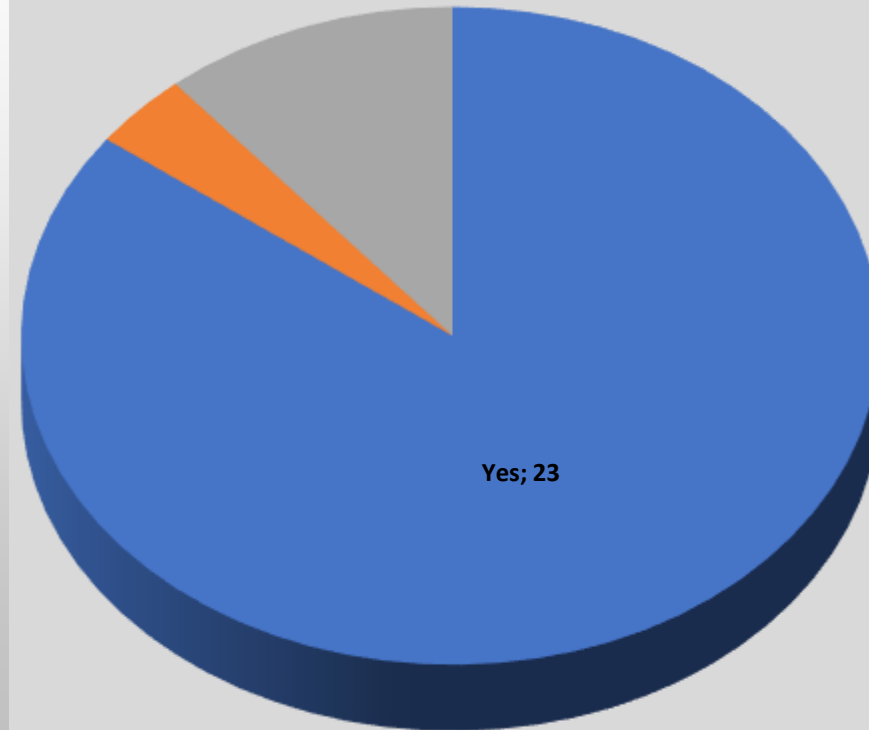
