Following on from the 2022 GA, having developed some wonderful valuable and value creating relationships with Dance Movement Therapy Associations from across the globe, including Columbia, India, Argentina, & Brazil, which were infused by our monthly meetings online, we looked together at how we would move forwards as a working group.

We are keen to move forwards together with the EADMT Board and their vision for this working party.

Between the EADMT GA in 2022 to date we have met online 8 times and exchanged messages and emails. It was not clear in our first meetings in October and November last year how we would develop as a working group, so we spoke a lot and shared our thoughts.
