

Membership Committee report, summary - 2022/2023

The following actions has been taken during this time period:

1. **Coordination of the reviewing process for a) Austria and b) Lithuania**

- a. **Austria;** The review process has been done by the membership committee as Austria applied to change a membership level from Full Basic Membership to Professional Full Membership.

The status of the process are:

- The membership committee has received confirmation that Austria has completed the requirement to become a full professional member.
- Therefore we, in the membership committee, recommend voting at the GA for Austria to become a full professional member.

- b. **Lithuania** has applied to change membership from Associated membership to Full Basic Membership.

The status of the process are:

- The membership committee has received an application form and all the documentation confirming that they fulfill the requirements for full basic membership level.
- Therefore we, in the membership committee, recommend voting at the GA for Lithuania to become a full basic member.

2. **The membership committee has worked on changes in the documentation of the renewal process to make it more user friendly. Two documents have been made.**

- a. We have prepared formulations at Rules of Procedures point 6.7 - 6.7.6. Application and renewal procedure, to be voted on at the GA.
- b. Guidelines for Membership Renewal (to be visited at the EADMT homepage).
- c. Supplement a text in the application form of Full Professional Membership.
