

Summary EADMT Research WG September 2024

Mission and Vision:

For the year 2022/2023 our guiding motto for this year's tasks was:

connect - exchange – collaborate - continue - initiate

The mission statement of the EADMT research group introduced the following basic ideas:

The aim of the EADMT research working group is to support and promote knowledge development [on research] in the field of DMT. The activities of the EADMT research group seek to connect interested parties and offer opportunities for networking and dialogue on research for DMT professionals.

EADMT research committee aims at contributing to the circle of knowledge development on DMT related topics by

- supporting EADMT members on their collaboration on European projects to create knowledge,
- adopting available knowledge by offering access to and distribute available research resources.
- participating in the scientific committee for the bi-annual conference by reviewing calls and conference submissions.

Situation of the EADMT Research WG in 2023/2024

Throughout the year some new members joined the EADMT research working group (Alenka Simonic and Elien Matthijis) and others left (Rozelien Callaerts and Nira Shahaf). All new members need to be introduced, and they decided with which team (database/science café/facebook group) are more capable to collaborate.

The larger group met twice, from January until September. In between the small teams met as well self-steering in their activities, but with less frequently.

Output year 2023/2024

1. Aims agreed in last GA

- To get more visibility in social media
- 4th Science Café in November 2023 with over 50 participants

2. Keep the Research WG together

- 3 meetings between November 2023 and September 2024
- Small teams short meetings

3. Collaboration

- with conference WG looking for reviewers for the 5th conference in Vilnius (September 2025)
- we tried with Communication WG bringing some content of last Science Café

4. Meeting with the board in June 2024:

- To contact and meet professionals who are active in research (research mapping)

5. New Forum in two steps:

- First direct contact with all national associations to reach researchers and people interested or ready to engage in the sector
- Offer an online Forum to exchange knowledge on experimental studies and ongoing researches and to lay the foundations for possible future collaborations
- Invitation to meet face to face in the dedicated space-time for research during the 5th conference in Vilnius

Further actions 2024/202

- To offer a forum to match professionals of DMT from various countries, who can collaborate in a research project or communicate their interest to present in a conference.
- Contact national associations to reach people who are active / interested in research
- Offer an online European Forum to exchange knowledge and talking on ongoing research
- Possibility to meet face to face during the 5th conference
- To be more visible in social media
- To write a letter address to WHO – Arts & Health supervised by the Board.
